Over time, this causes paint to peel, rot, and even gutters to come off. A drip edge extension gives water a clean, controlled way to leave the roof, which gets rid of these problems.

The extension makes a small but important overhang. The metal lip on the extension catches rainwater as it slides off the shingles and drops it cleanly into the gutter trough. That simple change protects both the fascia board and the wood behind it. It also stops water from pouring down behind the gutter and getting into the soffit during heavy storms.
